### Treasurer

The Big Walnut Local School District is located in Delaware County, Ohio, approximately 30 minutes northeast of Columbus. The district is seeking qualified candidates with strong financial, managerial, communication and organizational skills for the position of Treasurer. Preferred Qualities Include:

- A bachelor's degree or higher in Accounting or Finance
- A valid Ohio Treasurer's license/certificate or ability to obtain one
- Meet the standards established by the State Board of Education
- At least 3 years experience as a school or educational service center treasurer.
- Knowledge of the Ohio Revised Code
- Experience in budget preparation, fiscal and contract management
- Demonstrated ability to communicate with the Board, Superintendent, Staff and Community
- Demonstrated leadership abilities

The successful candidate will be offered a multi-year contract at 260 days per year. The candidate will report to the Big Walnut Local Schools Board of Education and preferably be available to start employment on or about February 15-26, 2010. Compensation for the position is negotiable and dependent upon training and experience. The position will include attractive and competitive benefits.

The Big Walnut schools serve about 3,050 students in five schools, with a new elementary opening in 2010 and a new middle school opening in 2011. The Big Walnut Local Schools current operating budget is approximately \$25 million. The district has earned an Excellent rating for the past four consecutive years on the State of Ohio Report Card.
