

STACK

Structured Teaching for Autistic & Communication-delayed Kids

The STACK program provides a continuum of educational services for students with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and their families. The STACK program is based on the principles of the TEACCH model from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and provides a structured learning environment that recognizes differences in rate and nature of development within and among children with ASD.

STACK Summer Program

The Educational Service Center of Central Ohio offers the STACK Summer Program to students that participate in ESC classrooms throughout the school year. The STACK Summer Program is designed to extend the basic structure that the students benefit from during the school year into the summer months.

The program serves as a model program as the ESC provides STACK training to other professionals. Participants in the weeklong STACK training will work with students in the summer program to create materials and activities based on a specific student's needs and interests and teach those activities to the student in a supervised one-on-one setting. A licensed teacher will be overseeing the STACK summer program at all times.

Program Components

During the summer program students will practice social, leisure, self-help and academic skills daily. Students in this program will benefit from:

- One-on-one sessions with a teacher
- Review of academic skills
- Social skills practice
- Independent work sessions
- Arts and crafts projects
- Outdoor leisure time
- Group games and activities

Schedule

The STACK Summer Program will run Tuesdays through Fridays from 9 a.m.-2 p.m. beginning Tuesday, June 21, through Friday, July 22.

Location

The STACK Summer Program will be at Taylor Road Elementary School, 8200 Taylor Road, Reynoldsburg, OH 43068. Upon acceptance into the program, directions will be sent along with registration materials.

Registration

A confirmation notice as well as registration materials will be sent upon acceptance into the program. Class availability will be based on the number of students who apply for each grade level.

Cost

Participants must pay \$200 upon receiving registration materials.

Lunch

Students will need to bring a packed lunch daily.

Transportation

Parents will be responsible for the student's transportation to and from the STACK Summer Program.
